Summary of the meeting

15-17 October 2024 - Santiago de Chile

First Strategic Meeting of Focal Points of Justice and Security Institutions of Latin America for the EL PACCTO 2.0 Program

The meeting gathered by representatives from 79 Latin American justice and security institutions, aiming to strengthen the dialogue between the European Union and Latin America (EU-LA) through identification of joint the opportunities. The meeting will facilitate the planning of actions for 2025, co-creating the Latin America Strategy – EL PACCTO 2.0, which addresses the main priorities of the region. The dialogues were structured in regional panels and national round tables to maximize inputs. The Ministers of Interior and Justice of Chile and the European Union Ambassador to the country participated in the opening meeting.

Officials with high technical responsibilities, formally appointed by national and regional public institutions to actively participate in the EL PACCTO 2.0 Program, serving as channels of information and planning for their institutions and coordinating their integration into the regional work lines of the Program.

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Results of the meeting:

Latin American countries made contributions to the 2025 work plan of EL PACCTO 2.0 through their focal points.

Bilateral meetings were held to gather demands and design regional work proposals for 2026

Countries worked on the plan for the System between the Prosecutors' Offices of Latin America and **EUROJUST**

Priority topics, highlighted by Latin American Enhanced Cooperation institutions, were addressed during the meeting through workshops. These topics were the result of surveys conducted prior to the meeting.

THE FOCAL POINTS AND EL PACCTO 2.0 WORKED TOGETHER IN WORKSHOPS:

The main objective of these workshops was to validate and test the shared priority blocks, based on the results of a survey conducted with institutions prior to the event. The 76 focal points were divided into 8 working groups, addressing the priority topics highlighted in the survey, such as: regional cooperation tools, asset recovery, prevention, combating drug trafficking, and artificial intelligence in relation to organized crime. This process was essential to move from data collection and analysis at the national level to designing a strategy for the program that encompasses multiple countries and regions.











Bilateral meetings were held to identify regional cooperation demands on issues such as drug trafficking, cybercrime, environmental crime, arms trafficking, human trafficking, trafficking of cultural goods, corruption, economic crimes, and national penitentiary systems. National demands were identified, and as shared challenges were observed, regional and transnational actions can be formulated. Following country missions carried out, various organized regional meetings, and this strategic meeting, the Program has the necessary inputs for its Strategic Plan 2025-2026.
